

COLOURFUL CRAYON ART ON CANVAS

This super fun art activity involves turning your regular crayons into paint by melting them with a hairdryer! As they melt and drip down the canvas they create a rainbow of colour! Who knew?! Get ready to have some messy fun becoming a crayon artiste!

If you want to take this to the next level you can stick a unicorn, cloud or other stencil on the canvas before melting the crayons. Then once you're done, simply peel off the stencil and voila! You've got a really cool crayon art design on your hands.



WHAT YOU NEED

- Canvas
- Crayons with the labels removed
- Hot glue gun and hot glue sticks
- Hair Dryer
- Craft knife (make sure you ask an adult before you're using this)
- A drop sheet or messy place to work in!

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Lay crayons across the top of your canvas until you've completely covered the canvas from left to right. Once you know how many crayons you need, then start peeling off the labels! You can use a craft knife to help you do this if you need.

Step 2

Once all the labels have been peeled off the crayons, use the hot glue gun to glue them onto the canvas. Be very careful as the glue gun will get hot!

Step 3

Now for the FUN (and messy) part! Turn on the hair dryer and hold it over the crayons until they start to melt. Be patient! It sometimes take a little while.

TIP: Hold the canvas upright and hold the hair dryer so it's blowing down, so when the crayons melt they melt down the canvas to create that dripping effect!
