

FROSTY FROZEN INSPIRED SNOW ARTWORK

Missing the crisp cool air of winter? Wish you could experience real snow? Or perhaps you just love Frozen? Then we have just the art project for you!

Using shaving cream and food colouring, we'll create a magical Frozen inspired artwork!

Why not try this paper marbling technique with other colours too and make wrapping paper or special handmade cards!



WHAT YOU NEED

- Large Oven Tray
- Bamboo Skewer
- Blue Food Colouring
- Shaving Cream
- White Paper (2 Sheets)
- Orange Paper (1 Sheet)
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Black Marker Pen
- Ruler

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Cover the oven tray with shaving cream.

Step 2

Add a few drops food colouring in various spots on the shaving cream. Don't add too much so you get a beautiful marbled effect.

Step 3

Use your bamboo skewer to create some swirly patterns in the shaving cream.

Step 4

Gently place a piece of white paper on top and pat it down, then lift up the piece of paper and lay it down on a flat surface with the wet shaving cream side facing up.

Step 5

Hold your ruler and start scraping the shaving cream off the paper, starting at one end and working your way across. Try to scrape off all the shaving cream in one movement – check out the marbled effect!

Step 6

Add a Frozen inspired snowman to the artwork cutting out two round white paper circles for the head and body and an orange paper triangle for the nose, then draw on the eyes and buttons!
