

MAKE YOUR OWN JELLY SOAP

Why not make washing your hands THAT much more fun by making your very own soap that looks and feels like jelly?!

Get ready to wobble and wobble your way through this awesome crafting activity using only a handful of ingredients that are easy to get your hands on.

You will need an adult to assist with this as the recipe requires boiling water!



WHAT YOU NEED

- Gelatin Powder (2 tbsp)
- Boiling Water (2 cups) - ask an adult to help with this!
- Clear Liquid Body Soap (1 cup)
- Food Colouring
- Whisk
- Bowl
- Silicone Moulds

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Carefully pour the boiling water into the bowl and add the gelatin - whisk it until it is clear (i.e. the gelatin has dissolved in the water).

Step 2

Add 2 drops of food colouring and mix it together. Hint: don't go overboard with the food colouring, any more than 2 drops and you will end up colouring your skin when you use the jelly soap!

Step 3

Slowly pour the liquid soap into the mixture. Stir gently until combined. Avoid creating any bubbles when stirring or the soap won't set clear!

Step 4

Pour the mixture evenly into silicone moulds - any shape works!

Step 5

Leave them to set in the fridge for 1-2 hours. Your jelly soaps will melt on a hot day so store them in the fridge in a jar labelled DO NOT EAT!
