

MAGICAL FAIRY PLAYDOUGH

Normal playdough is fun...but fairy playdough is 10X better!

With a little bit of science magic it's easy to make too with only a couple of simple ingredients. Just follow the steps below to make fairy playdough that will flow like a liquid or break and crumble like a solid under pressure. This is a great sensory activity for younger children.



WHAT YOU NEED

- Cornflour (2-3 cups)
- Clear Hair Gel (300ml tub)
- Food Colouring
- Mixing Bowl
- Spoon

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1

Empty the tub of hair gel into your mixing bowl, add a few drops of food colouring and mix. As you mix add a small amount of cornflour and keep adding cornflour until your mixture forms a dough.

TIP: The amount of cornflour needed will vary depending on how much hair gel you've used. The key is the consistency, when it comes together into a ball, stop adding cornflour. It may require a lot of mixing.

Step 2

Knead the dough. Disclaimer - It may need lot of kneading! It's ready when it runs between your fingers like a liquid, but if you press down hard on it it breaks in half like a solid. If you feel you've added too much cornflour, then use a spray bottle filled with water to make it more runny.

Step 3

Play with your playdough! Remember you can store it in an airtight container in the fridge but you'll need to knead it again before playing with it each time.
